Entry Requirement:

- 1) A pass in Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) with at least credit in any THREE (3) subjects AND a pass in English Subject; or any other equivalent qualification
OR
- 2) A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.0) in any subject; or any equivalent qualifications
OR
- 3) A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Maqbul (pass)
OR
- 4) A pass in Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM) Level 3 in a related field, and a pass in SPM with a minimum of 1 credit in any subject
OR
- 5) Any qualifications equivalent to Certificate (Level 3, MQF).
